



## Effective Prayer Realms of Authority

James 5:16-17 (NASB)

**The effective prayer** of a righteous man can accomplish much.

### I. Spirit, Soul & Body

Genesis 2:7 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>7</sup> the LORD God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.

Genesis 1:26-28 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground." <sup>27</sup> **So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.**

<sup>28</sup> God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

### II. The World, the Flesh and the Devil

#### A. Spiritual Forces of Wickedness

Ephesians 6:12 (NASB<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>12</sup> For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

Luke 4:1-13 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>1</sup> Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the desert, <sup>2</sup> where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them he was hungry. <sup>3</sup> **The devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread."** <sup>4</sup> Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone.'" <sup>5</sup> The devil led him up to a high place and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world.

<sup>6</sup> And he said to him, "I will give you all their authority and splendor, for it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to." <sup>7</sup> **So if you worship me, it will all be yours.** <sup>8</sup> Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.'"

<sup>9</sup> The devil led him to Jerusalem and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. "If you are the Son of God," he said, **"throw yourself down from here."** <sup>10</sup> For it is written: "'He will command his angels concerning you to guard you carefully; <sup>11</sup> they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.'"

<sup>12</sup> Jesus answered, "It says: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"

<sup>13</sup> When the devil had finished all this tempting, he left him until an opportune time.

#### B. Sinful Nature

Galatians 5:17-21 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>17</sup> For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law.

<sup>19</sup> **The acts of the sinful nature** are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; <sup>20</sup> idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions <sup>21</sup> and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Romans 13:13-14 (NASB®)

<sup>13</sup> Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy. <sup>14</sup> But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to *its* lusts.**

### C. Present World Order

Ephesians 2:1-3 (NASB®)

<sup>1</sup> And you were dead in your trespasses and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience. <sup>3</sup> Among them we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest.

## III. Anticipating a Revelation

1 Corinthians 1:7 (NIV®)

<sup>7</sup> Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift **as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed.**

2 Timothy 4:6-8 (NIV®)

<sup>6</sup> For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time has come for my departure. <sup>7</sup> I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. <sup>8</sup> Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day--and not only to me, but also **to all who have longed for his appearing.**

Revelation 19:11-16 (NIV®)

<sup>11</sup> I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself. <sup>13</sup> He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. <sup>14</sup> The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. <sup>15</sup> Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. "He will rule them with an iron scepter." He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. <sup>16</sup> On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Psalms 91:9-16 (NIV®)

<sup>9</sup> If you make the Most High your dwelling-- even the LORD, who is my refuge-- <sup>10</sup> then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.

<sup>11</sup> For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; <sup>12</sup> they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

<sup>13</sup> You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent. <sup>14</sup> "Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

<sup>15</sup> He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

<sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."
