# Through the Cross A New Beginning

### I. Death and Life

Romans 4:25 (NIV®)

<sup>25</sup> He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.

#### A. Crucifixion

Romans 5:6 (NASB®)

<sup>6</sup> For while we were still helpless, at the right time **Christ died for the ungodly**.

#### B. Resurrection

1 Corinthians 15:17 (NASB®)

17 ... and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.

2 Corinthians 5:15 (NASB®)

15 ... and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and **rose again on their behalf**.

Cross = crucifixion and resurrection

## II. Outcome of the Cross

## A. Power Up ---made alive!

2 Timothy 3:5 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

5 ... **having a form of godliness but denying its power**. Have nothing to do with them.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>1</sup> But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. <sup>2</sup> People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, <sup>3</sup> without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, <sup>4</sup> treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God-

<sup>5</sup> having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them.

1 Corinthians 1:18 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>18</sup> For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but **to us who are being saved it is the power of God**.

1 Corinthians 1:23-24 (NASB®)

23 ... but **we preach Christ crucified**, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness, <sup>24</sup> but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ **the power of God** and the wisdom of God.

Romans 1:16 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

<sup>16</sup> I am not ashamed of the gospel, because **it is the power of God** for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.

#### B. A Total Defeat

Colossians 2:13-15 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

- When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, <sup>14</sup> having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. <sup>15</sup> And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.
  - Through the cross, Jesus administered to Satan a total, eternal, irreversible defeat.

## C. A Complete Redemption

Romans 8:31-32 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

2 Peter 1:3 (NIV®)

<sup>3</sup> His divine power has given us **everything we need** for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

## III. Approaching the Cross

Matthew 27:39-43 (NIV<sup>®</sup>)

Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads <sup>40</sup> and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" <sup>41</sup> In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. <sup>42</sup> "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the King of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. <sup>43</sup> He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

Luke 23:34-43 (NIV®)

<sup>34</sup> Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." And they divided up his clothes by casting lots. <sup>35</sup> The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One." <sup>36</sup> The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar <sup>37</sup> and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself." <sup>38</sup> There was a written notice above him, which read: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. <sup>39</sup> One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!" <sup>40</sup> But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? <sup>41</sup> We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong." <sup>42</sup> Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." <sup>43</sup> Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise."

## IV. Through the Cross

Colossians 1:19-20 (NIV®)

<sup>19</sup> For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, <sup>20</sup> and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

#### Prayer

Almighty God, I come to You in humility ---I need Your mercy. I cannot bring freedom and deliverance to myself. I lay aside my attempts and accept Your provision for my life. Forgive me of my sin as I forgive those who sin against me. I choose to live that Jesus may be honored through my life, I receive Him as Lord of all that I am. I rejoice that in Christ I am free of guilt and shame. I am a child of the Living God. May Jesus name be praised, amen.
